

Minutes of Elmsett Parish Council meeting held on the 24 April, 2017 at the Methodist Church Hall.

- 04.17.00 **PRESENT:** Mr A Newman in the chair, Mr N Bird, Mr G Hinton, Mrs M Hinton, Mr J Sones, Mr S Coram, two members of the public.
- 04.17.01 **APOLOGIES:** There were no apologies for absence.
- 04.17.02 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST ON AGENDA ITEMS:** There were no declarations of interest.
- 04.17.03 **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** The minutes of the meetings held on 6 March and 6 April were signed as accurate records.
- 04.17.04 **MATTERS ARISING:** John Sones commented on the recent litter pick which had been well attended and thanked all those who took part. The council now has equipment which can be used on further occasions.
- 04.17.05 **RECESS FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Charles Course attended the meeting and spoke about future options for development of land off Whatfield Road and would be interested to know what type of property residents would be interested in. He also said he would be happy to be involved with the village hall committee in building a new hall.
- 04.17.06 **CO-OPTION OF COUNCILLOR:** Andrew Woodgate had expressed an interest in standing as councillor. The members agreed to co-opt Andrew on to the council. He signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office. The chairman welcomed Andrew to the council.
- 04.17.07 **BROADBAND FOR ALL – COMMUNITY FIBRE PARTNERSHIPS –** John Sones reported that three individuals had come forward and that the school was also interested. He would therefore register the interest with BT and wait their response.
- 04.17.09 **PLANNING: B/17/00503 –** 4 Flowton Road – erection of single storey building (log cabin) annexed accommodation. The parish council had no objections to the approval of this application but did query the definition of ‘temporary’. **B/17/00889 –** 1 gate Farm Cottages – erection of two-storey side extension, single storey rear extension and detached cartlodge and construction of new vehicular access (amendment to B/16/00779/FHA) – As this was just an amendment to previous permission the council had no objection.
